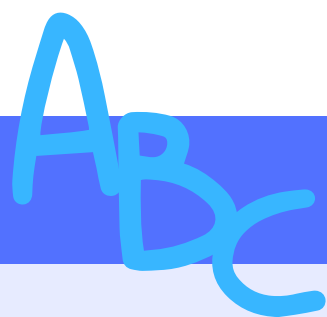

Gy pronounced "G" Example: Cye (take)

Kw pronounced "Kwah" Example: Akwasi

Ky pronounced "Ch" Example: Kyere (teach/show)

Tw pronounced "Chw" Example: Twi

Hy pronounced "Sh" Example: Hye (to wear)

Hw pronounced "Shw" Example: Hwε (to look)

Nw pronounced "Enwa" Example: Nwanwa (puzzled/
amazed)

Ny pronounced "Ny" Example: Nyansa (wisdom/ wise)
